

PROCEEDINGS

A brief introductory round for tutors and participants was held after registration for the workshop. Dr. Meenu Singh delivered introductory lecture on systematic reviews. She discussed about what systematic reviews are; their requirement and how do they fit in Evidence Based Medicine. Further, Dr. Bhavneet Bharti taught the participants about how to write a protocol and the steps to be followed for registering a protocol. Ms. Harpreet Kaur appraised the participants about steps for developing a search strategy for a review. She explained the steps with examples for strategies from Pubmed (Medline) and EMBASE databases. Dr. Nishant P. Jaiswal and Dr. T. Kiran Kumar discussed about quality assessment of studies for reviews. They delivered the lecture on data entry in Review Manager (REVMAN) software, the standard software for systematic reviews as prescribed in the Cochrane Library.

In the afternoon session, Dr. Meenu Singh, herself, discussed individual research questions from each participant and explained about the steps to be adopted for drafting protocol and helped in completing reviews of those participants who were on advanced stage of work.
